## Why a Festival of Bands?

The Band of Music of Pamplona had in its origin the celebration in Pamplona of a Band Festival on July 14, 1919. This Festival was held in order to support the initiative of several local musicians to create a Civil Band, given that In Pamplona there were 3 Military Bands but there was no city band.

In memory of those who organized that Festival and all the musicians who have passed through it, from La Pamplonesa we want to pay homage with the repetition of it, amplifying it to the artistic and social reality that we live today.

For this reason, the effort to make the Festival will serve to recognize the efforts of all the musicians who have passed through La Pamplonesa during this century of the Band's life, and to return to the city in the form of a festival the affection and follow-up that they have with the band.

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# 1.- Organization: La Pamplonesa Band of Music



[La Pamplonesa Music Band](#) was founded in 1919. On September 24 of that year the first board of directors was formed, in which D. Silvanio Cervantes was appointed director and was made up of 37 musicians. The first performance was the eleventh of October, playing through the streets of Pamplona Navarre popular repertoire.

From the beginning the band showed its quality, obtaining prizes in different competitions, such as the 2nd prize in the Band Competition of Zaragoza in 1922. Thus began its collaboration with the City of Pamplona, putting their music at the service of the main acts festive of the city. Since 1987 it is a Cultural Association and occupies a privileged place in the cultural activity of Pamplona. Since 1996 its director is J. Vicent Egea and currently enjoys a high artistic prestige among the music bands from all over the country.

In its activity highlights its cycle of concerts in the Gayarre Theater and in different stages of the Navarre capital. He also participates in all the civil and religious acts of the city and is the musical reference in the parties of S. Fermín, in which his music is part of the soundtrack of the city.

Realizes a great work of diffusion of the music, as much popular as of symphonic repertoire for band. It plays all kinds of musical genres, including jazz, zarzuela, classical music, contemporary music, film music and the great modern symphonic repertoire for the band. It also develops a pedagogical facet through the realization of instrumental courses and collaborations with educational entities such as Music Schools and Conservatories. And with entities of a social nature, in the form of campaigns promoted by said entities and concerts, both with their full training and in small chamber formations.



## Ground Floor Exhibition Hall & Mezzanine

The ground floor Exhibition Hall is an ideal space for trade fairs, salons, commercial exhibitions linked to congress and large-scale banquets. It has a surface area of 2,000 m<sup>2</sup> and a height of between 3-9.25 m, plus electrical/voice/data connections and running water. This hall has two independent accesses: one from the lobby and the other from the plaza.

Sala Mezzanine, located on level 1, can house exhibitions, presentations or catering services or act as a complement to the Exhibition Hall in trade fairs. It has a surface area of 1,000 m<sup>2</sup> and a height of 5.35 m, plus electrical/voice/data connections.



# 4.- Main venue Spaces and Services



## Main Auditorium

The Main Auditorium of BALUARTE, with 1,568 seats, offers an excellent view of the stage from any seat. The walls are panelled in beech wood, and the size and light of the auditorium mean that all kinds of cultural and congress activities can be held there. Access is from the ground floor, level -1 and upper floor. There is a cloakroom next to the main entrance doors on the ground floor.



## Chamber Hall

BALUARTE's Chamber Hall can accommodate 444 people and is the ideal place for medium-sized meetings or congresses. Located on the ground floor of the building next to the interior cafeteria, it is also used for concerts and other small-format cultural activities. It has its own cloakroom, located next to the entrance doors.

The hall has an audiovisual control booth with sound mixing board, lighting and simultaneous interpreting booths and a 5 x 4m projection screen. The 104 m<sup>2</sup> stage has a maximum depth of 7.2 m and a maximum width of 14.5 m.

## Conference rooms


There are three rooms on level -1 (Basement): Gola, Corona and Bulevar. Access is from the street or the lobby. These rooms are used for conferences and breakout sessions in congresses. Two of them have fixed seats and the third is an open space.

### Sala Gola & Sala Corona



With 97 seats each, covers 110 m2 and has audiovisual control and simultaneous interpreting booths.

### Sala Bulevar

Sala Bulevar covers 200 m2 and has capacity for 140 people in theatre layout and 75 in classroom layout. It has audiovisual control and simultaneous interpreting booths.

## Congress Rooms

On its third floor BALUARTE has views over the Citadel and the plaza through large windows in the lobby and corridors. The versatility of the Ciudadela & Luneta rooms, specifically designed for meetings and congresses, means that they can be arranged in different layouts through modular panels. The two rooms are separated by the third floor lobby.


**Sala Ciudadela** has a surface area of 440m<sup>2</sup> and a maximum height of 5m. It has 4 booths for audiovisual control and simultaneous interpreting and can be divided into eight small rooms.

**Sala Luneta** covers 440m<sup>2</sup> and a maximum height of 5m. It has 4 booths for audiovisual control and simultaneous interpreting and can be divided into four small rooms.

## Press room


This room, located on the -1 floor, is specially adapted for holding press conferences and working rooms for the media. It has twenty seats available with individualized sound, electricity and telephone, as well as a platform on the back for television cameras. The room has a projection screen and offers the possibility of simultaneous translation. The surface of the room is 75.1 m<sup>2</sup>.

## Main Lobby



The lobby is used for reception purposes, e.g. the distribution of congress credentials. The two large walls that mark it out correspond to the Main Auditorium and the Chamber Music Hall. Its large surface area (800 m<sup>2</sup>) allows it to house exhibitions, cocktails, breakfasts, etc.

## Host

Exclusivity, simplicity and flexibility are the features that best define this service, adapted to the needs of each customer: coffee breaks, cocktails, aperitifs, lunches or the most sophisticated banquets, of up to 1.800 people.

## Technical personnel

BALUARTE can offer state-of-the-art technical service to its customers, with the latest equipment and materials and highly skilled technical personnel in the fields of audiovisuals, lighting, montage and warehousing.

## Simultaneous Translation

BALUARTE can offer simultaneous translation services for up to 5 combinations of 5 different languages and has the necessary equipment in house

## Car parking

BALUARTE has an underground car park with capacity for 900 vehicles and electric car feeds. The car park, located on two levels, is open 24 hours a day and has direct access to the plaza by stairs or elevators

## Network capabilities

BALUARTE has free Wifi, with a network covering the entire building. It also has a LAN network with more than 3.000 LAN plugs available all over the building

## Environment

BALUARTE has been awarded the BioSphere Events Certification, granted by ITR and UNESCO, being the first Congress Center in Spain in obtaining the award. It ensures the coverage of sustainable and responsible practices in the entire value-chain.



## Electronic signage

There are electronic displays inside the building available for organizers. No external devices are built-in.

## Baluarte 2.0

BALUARTE has dedicated Community Management service for delivering in-time information about all the happenings in the building through Facebook and Twitter. The WEB page is updated daily.

# 5.- IFOB2019 in Gayarre Theater



The history of the **Gayarre Theater** dates back to 1841, when it opened its doors in the Plaza del Castillo under the name of Principal Theater. Later, with a stone-to-stone reconstruction of the old theater, it was moved to its current location on Carlos III Avenue, a place it has occupied since 1932.



Currently, it concentrates an important activity of the cultural programming of Pamplona and is the usual venue for concerts of the La Pamplonesa Music Band.

During the Festival, will host the opening ceremony, as well as various concerts of national and international music bands.

The interior of the building consists of four floors with about 900 locations. The first is the entrance hall to the room and the room itself, with a seating area of 462 seats. In this same floor there is, in addition to the stage (and pit for orchestras), the dressing room area, also divided into three heights.

The second floor of the building, with a capacity of 78 seats, houses the central stalls of the hall. The third floor, the box, consists of 182 locations, to which 12 must be added with reduced visibility. The theater still has a fourth floor, the amphitheater.

Also to being able to count on the Bands of different places of origin that register to the Festival, there will be a program of concerts and performances in which you will be able to enjoy formations and soloists of recognized prestige and international level as is the case, among others, of the Austrian metal group [Mnozil Brass](#) or the Venezuelan trumpet player [Pacho Flores](#).



We are working on the closing of participations of more artists and formations, the clarinetist José Franch, the trumpet player [Sarah Willis](#) or the [Habanera quartet](#) of saxophones ... we will also have the collaboration of the [Brass Academy Alicante](#) and that we hope to confirm in the coming weeks.



Another important part of the International Band Festival will be its presence on the street, where it will show its closeness to the public and will become a dynamic event for the city, as well as a fantastic setting for the bands that come to it.

During the days of this event you can enjoy street concerts, parades through the old town or a large parade on Saturday June 15 in which several hundred musicians will meet.



The program will be completed with an attractive and varied offer of music of all styles in different entertainment venues of the capital of Navarre at night, and completing a festival offer for all audiences and at any time of the day.

# 8.- Pamplona Sleeping Room Capacity in Hotels



## Overall Room Capacity

Pamplona has got 2.700 rooms overall between City Center locations and a radius of 5 kilometers. Restricting it to 3 km, places us on a total offer of 2.000 rooms.



## Apartments

Pamplona is used to receiving visitors for long stays, due to its educational and medical activity. To cope with that demand, there is also an extensive supply of apartments.



## Infrastructure

Pamplona has experienced an intensive growth in room capacity over the last ten years, resulting in a brand new set of hotels and apartments, ready to cope with the most demanding levels of service. Some of the old hotels of the city have been fully renovated, and one of them, Grand Hotel La Perla is included within the top-10 Hotels in Spain.

## Tourist Attractions

Pamplona is the place where Sanfermin, possibly the best known Festival in the world takes place. The bulls run in the street for 890 meters, between 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> of July. It was home of Hemingway, the place where “The Sun Also Rises” novel was set.



Pamplona is the first main city on the Camino de Santiago, the 700 kms pilgrim road walked by more than a million people per year. The award-winning exhibition Occidens, within the Cathedral attracts more than 100.000 people per year and it is situated on the city’s route of the Camino. Pamplona also contains the ancient walls and Citadel, which is one of the most relevant and spectacular defense infrastructure in Europe, now in the process of obtaining UNESCO World Heritage consideration.



Combining its famous gastronomy and wine with ancient history and architecture, the Capital City of the Old Medieval Kingdom of Navarre offers the visitors a wide range of possibilities to enjoy their leisure hours. In addition, in just some minutes drive, rainforests or deserts-like landscapes can be reached. Thus Navarre, a real land of diversity, provides the visitor an incredibly varied leisure offering.

## Visitor Statistics


Navarra receives 8.800.000 visitors per year, with more than a million during Sanfermin Festivals.

## Temperature/weather

Pamplona has got mild weather and sunshine between mid-May and mid-June. 18 °C average .



# 10.- International accesibility



## Air routes

Pamplona has got a national airport with several daily connections to Madrid. Pamplona is also connected several times a week with a main European hub (Frankfurt). Delegates would require connecting flights.

Pamplona has got two international airports, Bilbao (159km) and Biarritz (127km) in less than 90 minutes connection by road.

## Rail connections

Pamplona possesses a national train station with daily high-speed connections to Madrid (3 hours) and Barcelona (4 hours). The international train station of Hendaye (France) is at 1 hour drive from Pamplona.

## Road connections

Pamplona boasts a dense highway network, connecting by highway to all main destinations in Spain - Barcelona, Madrid, Bilbao and Zaragoza, and is just 1 hour drive from France (Hendaye)

**BALUARTE** has got agreements with **RENFE** and **IBERIA** for delegates attending events in **BALUARTE**, with up to 60% discount.

# 11.- Local accessibility



## Airport

BALUARTE, the Festival center, and main hotels are just 6km away from the national airport of Pamplona. It has also got two international airports, Bilbao (159km) and Biarritz (127km) in less than 90 minutes connection by road. Transit time ranges from local airport varies between 7 and 15 minutes at peak hour

## Rail connections

BALUARTE and main hotels are just 4km away from the railway station. Transit times range between 5 and 10 minutes at peak hour.

## Other considerations

Pamplona has all the advantages of celebrating an event in a mid-sized city: No distances, main venue right at the city center, no need for transportation during the event and all the support from a city for whom a Congress of 1.500 delegates makes the difference



## **The venue**

BALUARTE was built with disabled people as a top priority and all the spaces and rooms are fully accessible for disabled people, including stages, dressing-rooms and common areas.

## **The city**

Pamplona has been awarded internationally for its sustainability and accessibility within “Access City Award 2.013” a contest led by European Union, granting and exceeding the fulfillment of European Legislation in the matter.
